

Foundation Level Sample Speaking Exam Task Sheet

Greet the student.

Hello (name of student). Let's start now.

Ask the following warm-up questions in order to help them reduce their stress level.

This part is not graded.

**How are you?
How old are you?
Where are you from?**

TASK-1-

Ask all the questions one by one. If a student indicates immediately that he/she does not understand the question, **you may repeat the question one time. Do not show the question to students. Do not paraphrase the question.** If student indicates that he/she is unable to answer the question after repetition, move on to the next question.

- **What do you usually do on the weekends?**
- **What did you do on your last birthday?**
- **What is your favourite day/season/month? Why?**
- **Talk about your daily routine.**

TASK-2-

Show student the picture and ask him/her to describe the picture. **Give the student around 10 to 20 seconds to think.** Then, say "Please describe the picture. You should speak about the picture **for a minute**".

P.S. Students are expected to use the language forms and vocabulary covered in our course content.

(Pronouns / There is/ There are & Simple present / Present continuous tense/ Adjectives / Prepositions/ colors / Describing physical features etc.)



If the student has stopped speaking and you are unsure whether or not they are finished, ask "Is that all?" or "Have you finished?" After the student is done speaking, say:

"Thank you. That is the end of the speaking assessment."
