

### Phase of Progress (POP) Level System

Our Preparatory Programme includes 28 weeks of classes. Lesson hours are from 8.30 to 13.00 from Monday to Thursday, and from 8.30 to 12.05 on Fridays.

The programme is divided into four periods known as POP. The duration of each POP period is 7 weeks; however, Upper-intermediate level in POP 1 and POP 3 lasts 14 weeks.



The programme comprises of four levels which correspond with Common European Framework of Reference classifications. The first level is **Foundation** and it is equivalent to A1, the second level **Pre-Intermediate** is A2, the next level **Intermediate** is B1 and the exit level **Upper-intermediate** is B2.



Students are required to pass the level that they complete in any given POP period in order to progress to the next level or, in the case of Upper-intermediate students, be entitled to sit DÜİYES. Students' progress varies depending on their success in each POP period. Possible scenarios based on starting level are as below;



### Assessment and Evaluation

Students' progress in each level is measured by exams and portfolio tasks. Pass score for each level is 60 and it allows students to transfer from one level to another. Students are expected to complete the Upper-intermediate level successfully (with pass score of 60) to be able to take the proficiency exam (DUIYES). Students with a DUIYES pass score (60) and above are entitled to start their education in their departments.

### **Exam Specifications**

### Midterm

Midterm exam assesses your progress during the 4th week of each POP period. The exam includes Listening, Reading, Grammar, Vocabulary and Writing sections.

### Portfolio

Portfolio consists of two components: Writing and Online Study Platform.

Writing includes two writing tasks taking place on separate days during a POP Period.

Students are allowed to use print dictionary during this process. Feedback session is held the following week in order to provide guidance to students by highlighting their strengths and weaknesses in writing skills.

Online study platform, the other component of the Portfolio assessment, assesses your performance on different skills. You enter the system via the codes provided in your course book and register for your online class using the class code given by your main teacher. You are assigned weekly tasks which need to be completed within a week following their assignment. It is an out-of-class practice which allows more autonomy for you while providing an opportunity to practice what you have learned on your own time and pace.

### Speaking Exam

Speaking exam assesses your speaking performance on the 5th week of each POP period. Students are required to take exam on specified dates and venues.

### Quiz

The quiz is a component of a 14-week Upper-intermediate level assessment. It includes Listening, Reading, Grammar, and Vocabulary questions.

### Pop Exam

POP exam assesses your progress at the end of each POP period. The exam consists of two sessions: Paper 1 and Paper 2. Paper 1 includes Listening, Reading, Grammar, and

Vocabulary sections and Paper 2 includes a writing section.

# Doğuş University English Proficiency Exam (DÜİYES)

DÜİYES is a proficiency exam equivalent to CEFR B2 level and students must obtain at least 60% from DÜİYES to be eligible to be transferred to their degree programmes. The exam consists of two sessions. Paper 1 includes Reading, Listening, Grammar and Vocabulary tasks. Paper 2 includes an essay writing task.

DÜİYES administered at the beginning of academic year is open to all students of the programme (both newly registered students that have passed the Online Placement Test and the existing students). However, DÜİYES at the beginning of academic year and at the end of academic year are held only for students who have completed the Upper-intermediate level successfully.

### **DÜİYES** Dates

DÜİYES is held three times in an academic year:

- It is administered at the end of fall semester for students who have completed Upperintermediate level successfully.
- It is administered at the end of academic year for students who have completed Upperintermediate level successfully.
- It is administered at the beginning of academic year for newly registered and existing students.

The English Proficiency Exam dates are announced in the academic calendar and on the official website. (ydb.dogus.edu.tr)

## Nationally and Internationally Recognised Exams

The English language proficiency of students can also be determined according to the results of other international or national tests that are recognised by our university. If requested, students can take these exams, which are equivalent to DÜİYES, in order to prove their English language proficiency.

Exams recognized by the university senate and the minimum scores required are as follows:

# STUDENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (OBS)

The student information system is a browser-based data collection and announcement tool which is used in the English Preparatory Programme. You can access various lists and reports, instructor and course evaluation questionnaires, attendance, grades, and your progress. The username and password are provided right after the registration process by Student Affairs Office.

To login, you need to enter https://obs.dogus.edu.tr/oibs/ogrenci/login.aspx into the browser or you can download the application.

### ENGLISH SPEAKING ENVIRONMENT

You are required to communicate in English throughout your education period at DUEPP.

### ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

You must attend at least 85% of your lessons during a POP period. If you exceed 15 % of absences, you are not allowed to sit POP Exam and you fail the level. Late-comers are marked absent.

### **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

All announcements related to the preparatory programme students (weekly objectives, exam dates, venues, class lists, exam outlines, rubrics, assessment weightings, student trainings, extra-curricular activities etc.) are posted on the notice boards and the official website. Besides, throughout the online processes, the announcements are often mentioned by Academic Advisors or sent via e-mail. You are expected to check the board and the website regularly to follow the announcements. It is presumed that you have read and fully understood the announcements.

### FOCUS GROUP MEETINGS

Focus Group Meetings, in which students provide feedback on their learning experience at DUEPP and share their academic, social, and physical resources demands, are held periodically. These meetings are held at the end of each POP period in line with the predetermined questions and two representative students from each class are nominated by their classmates. You may share your feedback, suggestions, and complaints in these meetings held by the Head of Unit / the Deputy Head of Unit and the Education Managers. Data gathered in these meetings are used to ensure the sustainability of training and organization quality.

## FEEDBACKABOUTTHEASSESSMENT RESULTS AND OBJECTIONS

DUEPP acknowledges the importance of giving feedback to students about their performance in the assessment processes. In order to see your exam paper, get some feedback and request the reevaluation of the exam paper, you need to submit a petition to the Foreign Languages Unit Secretary within five working days after the announcement of the exam scores.

### STUDENT DEVELOPMENT

### Student Orientation Programmes

Orientation programmes play a significant role in student development. The orientation programme for students at DUEPP consists of two steps. The first orientation session with new students is conducted by the Head of Unit in the main conference hall at Doğuş University on the first day of the academic year. Following that, academic advisors will welcome you in classrooms with the second step of orientation with a more detailed session. You are provided with all the necessary information about DUEPP and made aware of the responsibilities and expectations you are to meet in order to succeed in the programme.

### Trainings and Conferences

DUEPP gives particular importance to trainings and conferences to enhance students' motivation and self-improvement. Various trainings and conferences are held each academic year, and our students are granted with a unique opportunity to meet speakers from other countries, listen to their experiences and suggestions, and make connections to their learning experiences at school and beyond. In this way, students become more aware of not only their own learning experience, but also intercultural aspects of learning a foreign language.

#### Demo Lectures

Students are granted with the opportunity to attend demo lectures conducted by DUEPP under the aim of getting the academicians at the faculties together with the students. These lectures provide an insight into their prospective learning experience in their departments.

### Extra-Curricular Activities

Beside lessons, DUEPP organizes several extra-curricular activities to motivate students and enrich their learning experience. Quiz Shows, Vocabulary Competitions, and Debates are held during the academic year as a part of our extra-curricular activity programme. Also, you are welcome to participate in Oxford Students Academy Reading Competition to enhance your life-long learning skills. You are highly encouraged to take part in these activities.

### **Academic Advisor**

Each student in DUEPP has an academic advisor. This advisor is the main teacher of the student within their current POP period. The main duty of the academic advisor is to guide you through the teaching and learning process and assist you with queries you might have during your studies at DUEPP. Students are informed about the details at the beginning of each POP period.

#### Office Hours

Learning is not limited to 24-hour lessons each week at DUEPP. You are also encouraged to continue your learning outside the classes with the help of office hour sessions. Each teacher has two office hours during each week in order to provide guidance and assistance. Office hours are announced to students at the beginning of each POP period.

### COURSE MATERIALS

Students are expected to attend the classes with course materials (textbooks, paper or notebooks, pencils, dictionaries, etc.). Students are required to bring original copies of textbooks at all levels. It is a disciplinary and criminal offense to attend classes with non-original or photocopied books. Therefore, non-original books will not be allowed to be used in the classroom.

### SUMMER SCHOOL

Opening of summer school is regulated by the permission of the Higher Education Council, and its form, duration and conduct are regulated by the principles determined by the Senate. If a sufficient number of students are enrolled, education can be offered at the Foundation, Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate and Upper-Intermediate levels during the summer period.
